## About us

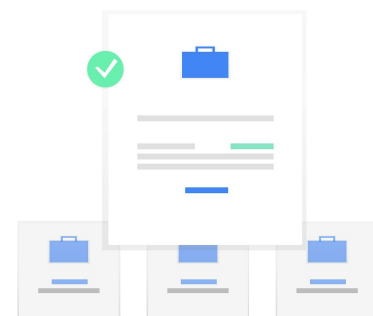

  - You can select something from a database with a clever SQL query. Ideally, you have experience with time series databases.
  - You feel at home in a command-line environment, and you know your git.
- You are able to deliver on a product development roadmap, on-time and on-spec.
- You take ownership and are proud of your work. We value people who learn from mistakes and improve themselves in tiny ways every day. You're open to learn new technologies.
